PY2022 QHP Certification Issuer Toolkit

The PY2022 QHP Certification Issuer Toolkit consolidates important information about the PY2022 QHP Application, and includes lists of tasks for issuers to complete throughout each step of the QHP Application submission and certification process. These checklists include information on relevant deadlines, next steps once review results are shared, and important reminders for completing actions required for certification. CMS has also provided links to additional resources throughout this document that issuers should access for more information on each topic. This toolkit is a supplemental resource and is not intended to replace official guidance or instructions. Acronyms used throughout are defined in [Appendix A](#).

How to Use This Resource

While CMS encourages all issuers seeking certification to review this resource in its entirety prior to initiating a QHP Application, each section is relevant and applicable to specific stages of the QHP certification process. 2. Application Initiation

Issuers seeking QHP certification should follow the steps below to prepare for QHP Application submission.



Review Resources Available to Issuers

- Download and review** the resources posted to the [QHP certification website](#), including [application materials](#), [instructions](#), training videos, [published guidance](#), and system user guides.



Confirm Submission System Access

- Contact your state** to confirm the appropriate state Exchange model type ([Appendix B](#)) and submission system. Visit the [State Exchange Models](#) and [Submission Systems](#) webpages for additional information.
- Obtain HIOS access.**
 - Review [HIOS User Guides](#).
 - Get standard component IDs, or “plan IDs.”
 - Update HIOS user roles and administrative data.
 - Obtain access to the required QHP and URR modules.
- Obtain SERFF access**, if needed.
 - Issuers in states performing plan management functions and SBE-FPs submit their QHP Applications via SERFF; issuers in FFE states should confirm with their state whether they are required to obtain SERFF access.
 - Contact [NAIC](#) or the [SERFF Plan Management Help Desk](#) for support.



Confirm PM Community Access

- Ensure at least two members** of your parent organization have [PM Community](#) access.
 - Email the [MSD](#) to request access, if needed.
 - Parent organizations with issuers that offer QHPs are able to request access for up to five users; those whose issuers offer only SADPs can request access for up to four users.
 - Review the contact list in the PM Community for any needed updates. Reference the [Register for Updates webpage](#) for more information on managing PM Community contacts.
 - Review guidance posted to the PM Community homepage’s Resources and Training tab, including user guides, training videos, and FAQs.

CMS Recommends...

Setting periodic reminders to regularly check your parent organization’s PM Community contact list for needed updates.



Verify Exchange Requirements

- Verify accreditation standards** are met for all issuers in your parent organization.
- Complete the Voluntary SADP Reporting Template** emailed from CMS and submit it to dental@cms.hhs.gov (PY2021-certified SADP issuers only).




3. Application Material Requirements (by Deadline)

This section provides checklists of materials required for each QHP Application submission deadline in the [timeline](#); each checklist denotes which materials are required for each Exchange type (FFE, state performing plan management functions, or SBE-FP), as well as plan type (QHP or SADP). Issuers in states performing plan management functions and SBE-FPs are encouraged to work with their states to determine any state-specific application submission requirements and deadlines.


You may be required to submit additional justifications or supporting documents not listed in the checklists in this section, depending on your issuer's specific circumstance. Early Bird Deadline

The Early Bird review round is optional for issuers seeking QHP certification. Issuers that choose to participate must submit the required materials outlined below by the Early Bird submission deadline in the timeline. CMS will conduct a limited number of reviews on the data submitted and release review results to issuers and states prior to the required initial application submission deadline, offering issuers an additional opportunity to review and make corrections.

Initial Deadline

Issuers seeking QHP certification must submit their QHP Application(s) to CMS by the initial submission deadline (“initial deadline”). These applications must include **all plans** the issuer is considering offering for the upcoming plan year; new plans will not be accepted after this deadline.

- Use the table below and the [Application Submission checklist](#) to submit QHP Application data for the initial deadline of 6/16/21.

Secondary Deadline

Issuers seeking QHP certification must submit their rates data to CMS by the initial Rates Table Template submission deadline, or “secondary deadline.” Reference the [Rate Review Requirements \(by Deadline\) checklist](#) for additional information on rate review submission. While issuers are required to submit the Rates Table Template and URR data, if applicable, to CMS by the secondary deadline, CMS also encourages issuers to review the results released in the PM Community thus far and submit corrected application data by this deadline. CMS will conduct additional QHP certification and data integrity reviews on revised QHP Applications that are submitted by the secondary deadline, and will post additional review results in the PM Community prior to the final submission deadline, providing issuers with an additional opportunity to review and make corrections.

- Use the [Data Changes and Corrections checklist](#) to make required corrections from the initial review round.
- Confirm that the EHB % of total premium value in the Plans & Benefits Template is accurate based on the relevant data entered in the URR Template.

Final Deadline

Issuers are required to finalize all application data by the final submission deadline (“final deadline”). After the final deadline, CMS will only allow changes on a case-by-case basis. With the exception of URL data, which is a required submission for all issuers by the final deadline, issuers are only required to resubmit other application materials if the issuer has made changes to its data to address CMS-required corrections.

4. Application Submission



Use the QHP Application Review Tools

CMS provides a number of review tools issuers can use to check their plans for QHP Application errors that would require corrections following submission.



Review Tools Webpage

- Download** the applicable review tools.
- Import** your application templates into each tool.
- Make application corrections** based on any errors identified.

Submit Your Application


Once you have completed all necessary application materials and have run the review tools, follow the steps below to ensure your application and Plan ID Crosswalk Template are properly submitted to CMS for each application submission deadline. Reference the [Application Submission webpage](#) of the QHP certification website for additional information. Issuers submitting [URLs](#), [machine-readable data](#), [URR data](#), and [administrative data](#) should refer to the relevant instructions for guidance on submission.



CMS Recommends...

Submitting completed parts of your application as soon as possible; do not wait until the deadline to submit application data.

Issuers in FFEs



HIOS User Guides

- Upload** materials to the applicable HIOS modules.
- Validate** each module.
- Cross-validate** your application.

Cross-validation is only required for the secondary and final deadlines. Be sure to return to the Final Submission tab, click "Cross Validate," and click "Submit."

Issuers in States Performing Plan Management Functions & SBE-FPs



SERFF Website

- Upload** materials to the applicable SERFF binders.
- Confirm** in SERFF that your state has transferred the most recent data for all plans to CMS.

Issuers that make changes to their SERFF binders after their initial submission should work with their state to ensure successful retransfer of the updated data.



SERFF Tips

Upload only one version of the Business Rules and Transparency in Coverage Templates to all SERFF binders to avoid template overwrite issues.

- Submit** your completed Plan ID Crosswalk Template and state authorization to CMS via the Plan ID Crosswalk Submission tab in the PM Community.

Check Your Submission Status

PM Community User Guide

Follow the steps below to check your application submission status in the PM Community for each deadline; please allow up to 48 hours for CMS to update this status after you have completed submission.

All Issuers

SERFF Tips

SERFF issuers should check with their state to ensure the state has transferred all SERFF binders before each deadline.

- Log into the [PM Community](#) and navigate to the Issuers tab.
- Select the relevant issuer ID/plan year combination; issuers may filter by plan year, if desired.
 - **Off-Exchange SADP and All New PY2022 Issuers:** If you are not able to locate the issuer ID for the current plan year, CMS has not received your QHP Application.
 - **PY2021-Certified On-Exchange Issuers:** If no plan IDs appear for the issuer/plan year combination, CMS has not received your QHP Application.
- Locate the “**Certification**” status.
 - **Early Bird and Initial Deadlines:** This status should read either “Pending Review” or “Pending Review and Submission of Rates.”
 - If the status is blank, CMS has not received a QHP Application for this issuer.
 - If the status reads “Not Eligible for CMS Certification,” the issuer’s application is incomplete and/or not eligible for CMS review or QHP certification.
 - **Secondary and Final Deadlines:** This status should read “Pending Review.”
 - If the status reads “Pending Review and Submission of Rates” for the secondary deadline, CMS has not received a Rates Table Template for this issuer.
 - If the status reads “Not Eligible for CMS Certification,” the issuer’s application is not eligible for CMS review or QHP certification.
- Confirm the “**Application Last Updated/Transferred**” date in the “Submission Details” section matches the most recent date on which you submitted your application or the date on which your state transferred this data to CMS.

Issuers in FFEs

- Locate the “**Application Last Cross Validated**” date in the “Submission Details” section to confirm that your application was successfully cross-validated in HIOS.
 - While cross-validation for the Early Bird and initial deadlines is optional, **you must cross-validate your application for the secondary and final deadlines** in order for CMS to receive the most up-to-date information submitted.
 - If the date displaying in this field is not as expected, log into HIOS and follow the steps outlined above to cross-validate your application

PY2021-Certified On-Exchange Issuers

- Log into the [PM Community](#) and navigate to the Plan ID Crosswalk Submission tab.
- Click on the relevant entry (begins with “CT-”) and **confirm the status is “Submitted.”** If the entry is still in a “New” status, click “Submit Template” in the top right corner to complete submission.



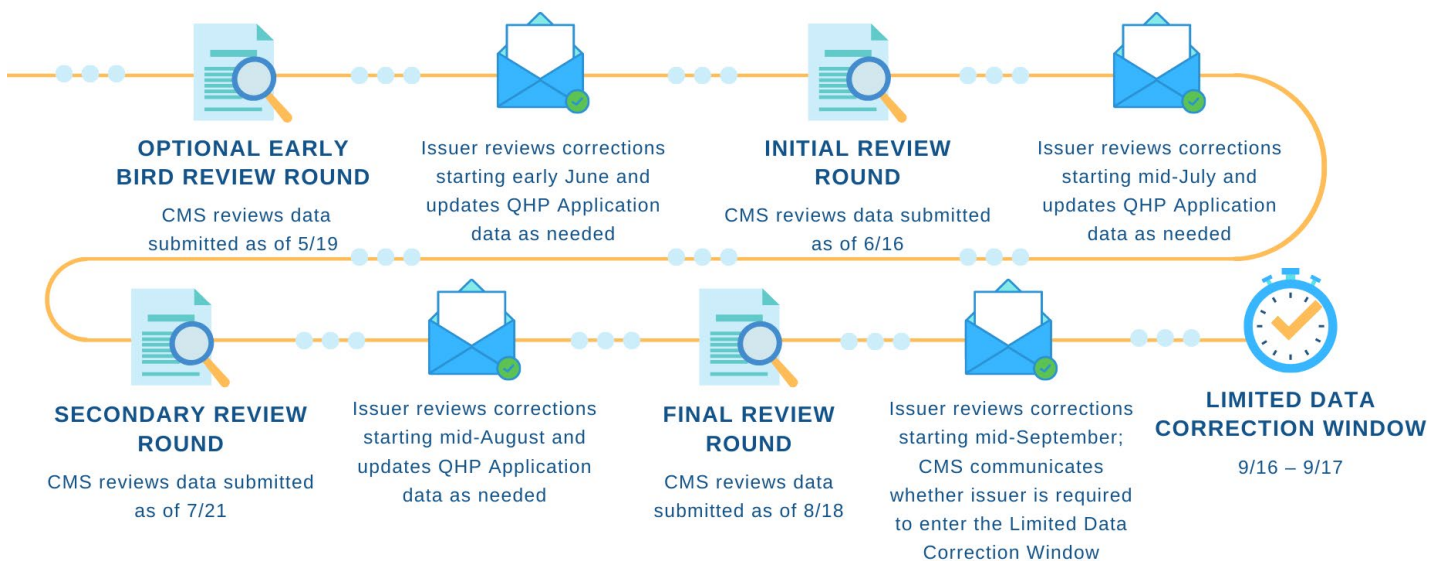
5. Data Changes and Corrections

 **Data Change Windows Webpage**

CMS conducts reviews during the certification process to identify areas of non-compliance with regulations or data integrity errors. After each review is complete, issuers have the opportunity to correct application data and may be invited to join a technical assistance call with CMS; CMS's technical assistance outreach recommendations for each required correction are displayed in the PM Community.

Throughout the QHP Application submission process, CMS releases review results to issuers in the PM Community on a rolling basis. These review results include required corrections that issuers need to make to their applications. As reviews are completed, CMS will update the PM Community with new review results and notify issuers and their states.

Access Your Review Results and Make Required Corrections

Common Issuer Corrections Guidance

- Review the [QHP Application Corrections webpage](#) to determine which reviews are conducted (1) for each Exchange type, and (2) during each review round.

- Review the email blast from “CCIIO Memos” for the following information:

- The review “as of” date.
 - CMS conducts reviews on application data submitted as of the most recent application submission deadline, and releases review results within a few weeks of each deadline. It is possible for an issuer to submit updated data in HIOS/SERFF *after* CMS has started its review. Please take the “as of” date into consideration when reviewing corrections.
- Whether new review results have been released for your state Exchange type.
 - CMS conducts different reviews for each state Exchange type (FFE, state performing plan management functions, and SBE-FP).
- Any next steps the issuer should take in response to the corrections released.

- Log into the [PM Community](#) and access review results in either the Corrections tab or Issuers tab.

- Make the required corrections to your QHP Application.

Early Bird, Initial, and Secondary Review Round Corrections

- Update the relevant application materials and resubmit them to CMS as soon as possible, but by no later than the next deadline.
 - *Reminder: Issuers in FFE states and states performing plan management functions that need to make service area changes **must** submit a DCR if the initial submission deadline has passed.*

Final Round Corrections

- Update the relevant application materials and confirm whether you are required to enter the LDCW or another submission window, as directed by CMS.

i SERFF Tips

SERFF issuers with required corrections should work with their states to make sure updated binders are transferred ahead of the next deadline.

Requesting Data Changes After the Final Deadline

DCR Instructions

Issuers in FFE states and states performing plan management functions must submit a DCR if application data changes that are not identified by CMS are needed after the final deadline. Issuers in SBE-FP states should contact their states if application changes are needed after the final deadline.

6. Certification Preparedness


Plan Preview




Plan Preview is a HIOS Module that allows issuers to view plan data as it would display to consumers in Plan Compare on HealthCare.gov.




Issuers are encouraged to use Plan Preview during the QHP Application period to make sure plans are displaying as intended, including accuracy of all URLs.



PY2022 Plan Preview will be available by April 2021 and can be used as a resource for issuers throughout the plan year.



All issuers in FFE states may use Plan Preview as soon as it is open and their plans are in “cross validation complete” status. Issuers that submit data in SERFF only see data in Plan Preview that their state has transferred to HIOS.



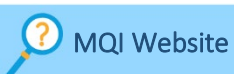

Use Plan Preview to Identify Plan Errors

- Access the Plan Preview Module via HIOS.
- Enter sample rating scenarios to view details and rates for associated Individual and SHOP plans.
 - Only plans that were cross-validated in HIOS or transferred via SERFF will display.
- Notify CMS immediately if issues are identified. Issuers will also have a chance to review their plan data during issuer testing.

Quality Data



QHPs are rated based on relative quality and price; quality rating information is publicly displayed for all Exchange types to assist in consumer selection of plans. QHP issuers are required to submit quality rating information as a condition of certification and participation in the FFE.

Rate Review Requirements (by Deadline)

URR Instructions

All QHP issuers are required to undergo rate review. Issuers should reference the below federal deadlines and check with their state regulators to confirm the state has not instituted any earlier deadlines. Depending on their specific circumstances, issuers may be required to submit additional justifications or supporting documents not listed below. QHP issuers should verify that they have the following:

- Access to the URR module of HIOS;
- The most recent version of the URR Template; and
- The most recent version of the URR Template Instructions.

Final Issuer Plan Confirmation

PM Community User Guide

As part of the QHP certification process, issuers must complete plan confirmation to submit their final plan offering decisions to CMS. During the plan confirmation window specified in the [timeline](#), issuers should review the list of plans loaded in the PM Community and confirm which plans should be made

available through the Exchange. Issuer plan confirmation is the final opportunity for issuers to notify CMS of plan withdrawals. The deadline to complete issuer plan confirmation is also the deadline to submit final Plan ID Crosswalk Templates to CMS in the PM Community.

 A *Completing Issuer Plan Confirmation* video is available on the *Resources and Training* tab of the PM Community homepage.

Complete Final Issuer Plan Confirmation

- Log into the [PM Community](#) during the final issuer plan confirmation window.
- View PY2022 plans requiring confirmation by using the available filters to narrow down the visible list of plans. Ensure a selection is made for all plans requiring confirmation before the deadline.
- Confirm all desired plans. Issuers have the option to:
 - Confirm all plans at once;
 - Confirm multiple, but not all, plans at once; or
 - Confirm a single plan ID at a time.
- Click “Save” after confirming the desired plans. If this step is not performed, users’ responses will not be shared with CMS.

CMS Recommends...

Selecting “Download Plans List” at the top of the screen to export your plan list if needed. This feature is available to issuers at any time—not just during plan confirmation.

CMS will email issuers the first day of the issuer plan confirmation window with more detailed instructions; you can also reference the PM Community User Guide posted on the Resources and Training tab of the PM Community homepage for additional instructions.

Following final issuer plan confirmation on the dates specified in the [timeline](#), state contacts will use the PM Community to finalize the list of plans in their state that are eligible for availability through the Exchange during the upcoming plan year. Final state plan confirmation gives regulators the chance to indicate whether the state does or does not approve the regulatory submissions of each plan for certification on the Exchange.

QHP Agreement Signing

Issuers offering on-Exchange QHPs or SADPs must sign and submit a QHP Certification Agreement and Privacy and Security Agreement (“QHP Certification Agreement”), and a Senior Officer Acknowledgement.



The QHP Certification Agreement includes provisions for safeguarding plan and participant privacy and standards for issuer testing before Open Enrollment starts. The agreement must be signed by an officer of the legal entity who has legal authority to contractually bind the issuer.



The Senior Officer Acknowledgement confirms that a senior officer of the issuer has knowledge of the content of the issuer’s plans, as well as the content of the completed attestations and the Letter to Issuers.



Complete the QHP Agreement Signing Process

Once you receive your agreement via DocuSign, take **one** of the following actions:

- Complete signing the agreement (authorized users only):**
 - Click “Review Documents.”
 - Review the QHP Certification Agreement, enter the appropriate information where indicated, and click “Sign” to provide your e-signature via DocuSign.
 - Review the Senior Officer Acknowledgement, enter the appropriate information where indicated, and click “Sign” to provide your e-signature via DocuSign.
 - Click “Finish” at the top or bottom of the screen.
- Assign the agreement to an authorized user to sign:**
 - Click “Review Documents.”
 - Click “Other Actions” and select “Assign to Someone Else” from the dropdown menu.
 - Enter the email address and name of the authorized user, and the reason for reassigning the document.
 - Click “Assign to Someone Else.”

CMS Recommends...

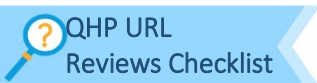
Completing the following activities before CMS sends QHP Agreements:

1. Log into the [PM Community](#) and confirm that your organization contacts are correctly listed. Users are encouraged to keep contacts in the PM Community up to date, so that relevant members receive the appropriate communications.

URL Submission



CMS requires issuers to submit URL data for the plans they intend to offer on the Exchange. Consumers should be able to view the relevant information at each URL without logging in, clicking through multiple webpages, or creating accounts/memberships/registrations.



Submit URLs

- Submit URLs by the deadlines outlined in the table below.** The table also includes where each URL is submitted and the date by which the URL needs to be live and active for the 2022 plan year.

**If you choose to submit a QHP Application for the Early Bird review round, Transparency in Coverage URLs are required by the Early Bird submission deadline, 5/19/21.*

All marketing URLs should be active and route consumers directly to the relevant information for their standard plan or plan variant by the time you have signed your issuer's QHP Agreement.

Certification Notices

As indicated in the Letter to Issuers, CMS will send Certification Notices to issuers at the conclusion of the QHP Application certification process. These notices prompt issuers to review final lists of certified plans and download CMS-countersigned QHP Agreements from the PM Community. The documents will apply to all QHPs, including SADPs, offered by a single issuer at the issuer ID level or designee company. **Receipt of a QHP Certification Agreement with CMS signature and final validated plan list completes the certification process for the upcoming plan year.** Certified off-Exchange SADP issuers will only receive a final validated plan list.

CMS reserves the right to identify and communicate corrections prior to and after certification based on the original QHP Application and any changes made to the application, or if CMS determines that any of the submitted information is inaccurate.



Download Your Countersigned QHP Agreement and Final List of Certified QHPs

Once CMS sends certification notices via email, follow the steps below to download the countersigned agreement and plan list attachments.

- Log into the [PM Community](#)** and navigate to the Issuers tab.
- Select the applicable issuer ID/plan year combination** and scroll to the Files section.
- Select and download** the CMS-countersigned QHP Agreement (on-Exchange only) and final plan list attachments.

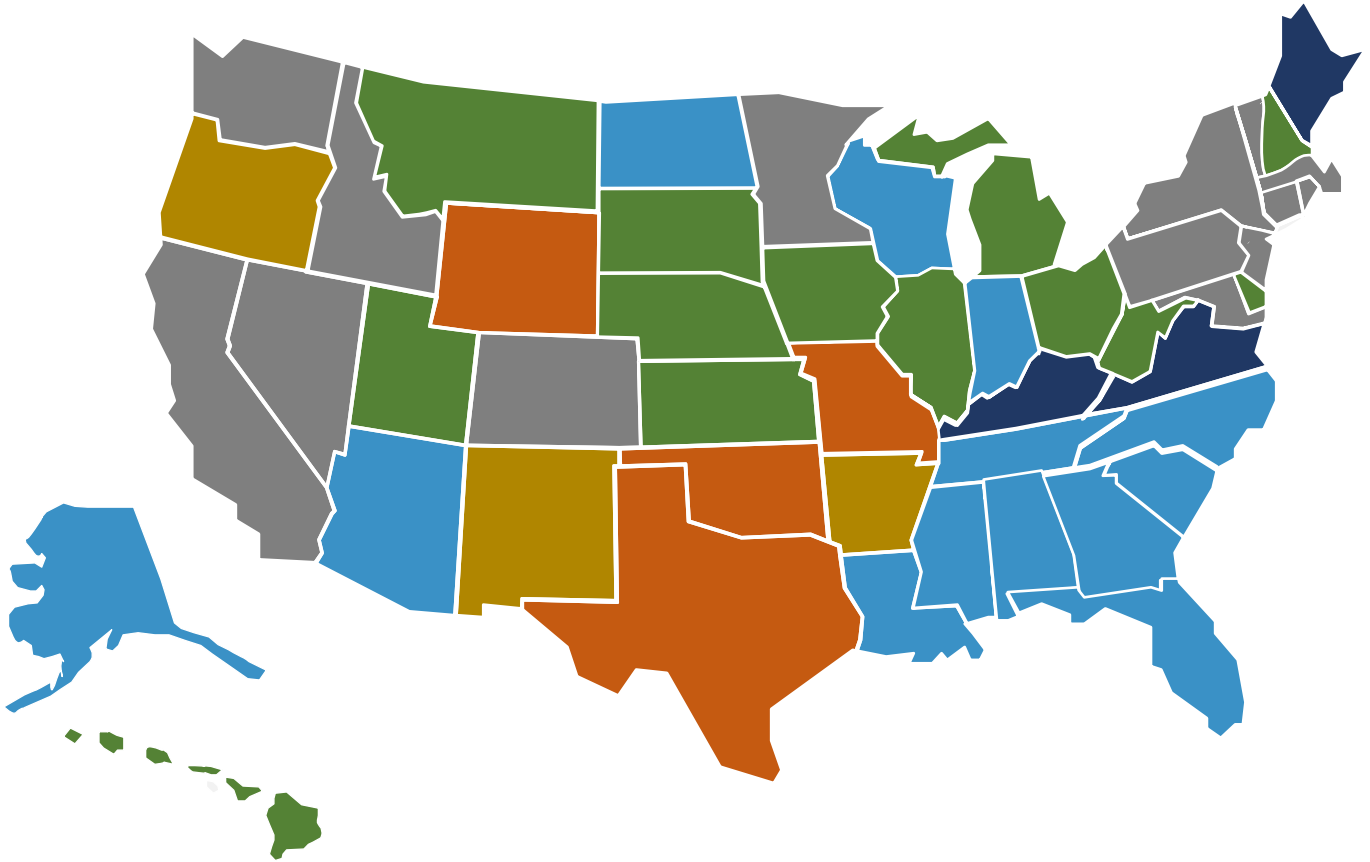
